
The Smart Approved WaterMark is a not-for-profit scheme designed to help consumers make an informed choice about saving water around their home, garden and pool. Mr Spithoven continues, "The addition of the Smart WaterMark label on the RWP and RWPi rainwater pump systems will give our consumers the confidence that they are buying a product which has been independently verified as a genuine water saving device."

The RWP and RWPi series of Rainwater Pump Systems are a flexible, easy-to-use solution for the automatic switching between rainwater and mains water supply. Already installed throughout Australia in a range of applications including schools, community halls and domestic housing, they offer a number of significant and unique advantages including:

- No mixing or usage of mains water when rainwater is available (mains water usage is completely stopped);
- No mains pressure drop (mains water supply bypasses the pump);
- Suitable for a range of pump brands & sizes;
- Capable of accommodating flow rates up to 90lpm;
- In the event of a power failure or depleted rainwater supply, the system automatically reverts to mains water supply.

The RWPi range is a unique, dual-outlet solution which delivers even greater control over where precious mains water is used. As with the RWP series, the RWPi rainwater pump systems automatically switch between mains water and tank water. However if the rainwater supply is exhausted, the RWPi system will supply mains water for household water requirements only – limiting irrigation water use to rainwater.

CAP Industries was granted the Smart Approved WaterMark in January 2009.
